


INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC LECTURER

Trainees awarded Executive Halal Certificates after all the conditions and requirements for this course have been met. Halal Executive Course Series-6 was successfully implemented for six weeks from 19 February until 27 March 2022. This course was participated by 10 participants from Halal Industry and university students.

The development of the International Halal Executive Course Module is a collaborative project between the Consortium Malaysian Institute of Halal Institute (KIHIM) and JAKIM. KIHIM comprises four higher education institutions namely Halal Products Research Institute (HPRI, Universiti Putra Malaysia), University of Malaya Halal Research Centre (UMHRC, Universiti Malaya), International Institute for Halal Research and Training (INHART, International Islamic University Malaysia) and Institute of Fatwa and Halal (IFFAH, Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia). 
LCMS QTOF WORKSHOP

HPRI has organized the LCMS QTOF (Liquid Chromatography Mass Spectrometry Quadrupole Time of Flight) Workshop: Basic Technique and Sample Analysis on 7 and 8 December 2022 at HPRI Seminar Room. This workshop lasted for two days with the participation of eight people consisting of seven graduate students from HPRI and one graduate students from UiTM. The objectives of the workshop were to provide in-depth exposure related to LCMS QTOF tools as well as to teach the basic techniques of using LCMS QTOF tools and accurate analytical methods in using LCMS QTOF tools. All participants were given the opportunity to use the LCMS QTOF tool and to test their respective samples using this equipment. At the end of the workshop, all participants were very satisfied with the journey of the workshop as well as the very interesting sharing by the workshop speaker, Mr. Liew Ting Kok from CX1 Services Sdn. Bhd. who has extensive experience related to the LCMS QTOF.









REGIONAL TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON HALAL SLAUGHTERING AND CERTIFICATION





The Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture (SEARCA) had partnered with HPRI to conduct the Regional Training-Workshop on Halal Slaughtering and Certification on 23-25 August 2022 at The Everly Putrajaya Hotel. The Training-Workshop was conducted to provide support to ASEAN's current initiatives and to foster greater collaboration among key players of the Halal industry.

The Training-Workshop aims to:

- Increase the exchange of knowledge and information among key players of the Halal industry and explore potential collaborations for its further development in the ASEAN region; and
- Enhance the capacities of Halal professionals, practitioners, policymakers, and other key players and stakeholders on Halal slaughtering and certification.

At most 25 representatives from the ASEAN Working Group on Halal Food (AWGHF), Halal researchers, academicians, industry and officers from certification and regulatory bodies/ministries from the ASEAN participated in the Training-Workshop.









CONGRESS ON SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SECURITY 2022 (COSAFS2022)

Congress on Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security 2022 (COSAFS2022) was held on 21 to 24 September 2022, at The Waterfront Hotel, Kuching, Sarawak, Malaysia. The staff involved were from HPRI Graduate and Research Unit. The program was officiated by Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri (Dr) Abang Haji Abdul Rahman Zohari bin Tun Datuk Abang Haji Openg, Chief Premier of Sarawak. The purpose of this program was to promote the field of study and services offered by HPRI. The estimated number of visitors to the booth were 250 people. VIRTUAL HALAL **MOBILITY 2022**





HPRI had successfully organized the Virtual Halal Mobility Program 2022 on 4 October 2022. This was the second time the programme was being conducted, said the chair person of the programme, Prof. Ir. Dr. Yus Aniza Yusof. The programme was conducted in 2021. A total of 112 participants including undergraduate and postgraduate students, staff, researchers, academics, industry players and the public from 9 countries were involved. The programme had attracted people from all over the world to learn and understand issues and perspectives related to the field of halal science globally. This program has been jointly organized with Bogor Agricultural Institute (IPB) Indonesia; Halal Science Center, Chulalongkorn University, Thailand; Sultan Sharif Ali Islamic University (UNISSA), Brunei and SAFE-Network Coordinator Asia Pacific Network for Sustainable Agriculture, Food and Energy (SAFE-Network). This program was sponsored by EXIM Bank Malaysia, Maybank Islamic, Waqf, Zakat and Endowment Management Center (WAZAN) UPM and Fonterra Brands Malaysia S/B. This program was also supported by Rozi Othman International Plt., CIRNET UPM and UCTC UPM.







RESEARCH EMPOWERMENT WORKSHOP 2022

Research Empowerment Workshop 2022 was held on 6 October 2022 at L'apprenti UPM. The program was attended by 35 Researchers, including research officers, associate researchers, and interim associate researchers. Four HPRI staff have served as committee for this program. In this program, researchers were divided into cluster categories according to their expertise. The objectives of the workshop were to strengthen research groups in the field of halal, to form synergies towards multidisciplinary research, to identify potential grant sponsors, to enhance halal research collaboration among HPRI researchers and to provide exposure and motivation to new researchers.











VISIT AND DISCUSSION WITH MUFTI **WILAYAH PERSEKUTUAN OFFICE**

On 8 July 2022, the Laboratory of Halal Science Research (LAPSAH) and Laboratory of Halal Services (LPH), HPRI visited Mufti Wilayah Office. The purpose of this visitation was to discuss the sertu procedure. The visit was attended by Assoc.Prof.Dr. Nor Ainy Mahyudin, the Head of LAPSAH and LPH, Dr. Mohd Hafis Yuswan and Dr. Nur Fadhilah as representatives from Research Officer and Dr. Nurhidayatul Asma as a representative from Science Officer.

FOOD DNA EXTRACTION METHOD DEVELOPMENT AND VALIDATION WORKSHOP

LAPSAH and LPH had organized a workshop on DNA analysis methods, namely Food DNA Extraction Method Development and Validation Workshop on 2, 7 and 8 December 2022, held at DNA Unit, LPH. The workshop involved four participants of students from UPM and UKM. The first day of the workshop focused on theoretical lectures on DNA structure and the process as well as the strategy in DNA extraction method development and validation given by Dr. Nur Fadhilah Khairil Mokhtar. Participants were exposed and trained with technical skills required for DNA analysis in the laboratory for the other two days by Dr. Nur Fadhilah Khairil Mokhtar and Dr. Nurhidayatul Asma Mohamad where they were allowed to bring their own samples to be analyzed. The practical session allowed the participant to learn to extract DNA from meat, processed meat and gelatin, and eventually analyze the DNA samples using real-time PCR instrument.













DISCUSSION FOR POTENTIAL COLLABORATION WITH MAQIS, MAFI

HPRI was given an opportunity to hold an initial discussion with one of the national authorities, Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services (MAQIS) at the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security on 7 September 2022 for further collaboration. The discussion was led by the Head of LAPSAH and LPH, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nor Ainy Mahyudin with the Deputy Head Director of MAQIS, Dr. Azhari Sharidan Abu Bakar. It was also attended by several other MAQIS officers including Ms. Siti Nur Ahmad, Dr. Mohd Syazuwan Abd Jalil, and Mr. Muhammad Ezamry Arpan as well as two IPPH officers, Dr. Nur Fadhilah Khairil Mokhtar and Dr. Nurhidayatul Asma Mohamad. The key point of discussion was to introduce the next-generation sequencing (NGS) method for species identification and the need for an efficient sampling method for inspection.











VISIT TO ECO ESCHROLL FACTORY

On 27 July 2022, several LAPSAH and LPH officers had been invited to visit a sertu product factory owned by Eco Bhd to learn about the process Sdn manufacturing sertu products from clay under the sertu project led by the Head of LAPSAH and LPH, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nor Ainy Mahyudin. The factory that is located in Shah Alam employs a simple production line to obtain clay water that is mixed water with a cleaning agent to make the finalized sertu product. The officers were accompanied by two managers of Eco Eschroll Sdn Bhd, Mr. Azman Abd Wahab and Mr. Zubir Ramli who thoroughly explained the manufacturing process and gave a tour of the factory.













DISCUSSION WITH MUFTI PERLIS OFFICE ON ALCOHOL ISSUES

The Laboratory of Halal Science Research has been invited to present and discuss the scientific data and evidence on alcohol issues in food and beverages. The discussion was held on 17 October 2022, via an online platform. 






STUDENT'S MOBILITY OUTBOUND


